**Subject:** Information regarding implementation of Admission policy, Reservation policy & ordinances under the Aryavart International University Tripura Act, 2023 - Submission thereof.

**Dear Sir,**

In reference to your letter No. F.2(399)-DHE/UDCA/2021/4999 dated 29/12/2025, seeking information regarding the implementation of specific provisions under the Aryavart International University, Tripura Act, 2023, the following details are submitted for your kind perusal:

## **1. IMPLEMENTATION OF SECTION 9(ii) - ADMISSION POLICY**

The University has implemented the admission policy framework as mandated under Section 9(ii) of the Act:

### **1.1 Admission Criteria and Process:**

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Undergraduate Programs: Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent from recognized board
- Postgraduate Programs: Bachelor's degree in relevant discipline from recognized university

#### **Admission Procedure:**

- Online application through university portal
- Merit-based selection through entrance examination/qualifying examination marks
- Counseling and seat allotment
- Document verification and fee payment
- Final admission confirmation

Admission to Aryavart International University is primarily merit-based. The selection committee evaluates candidates' academic achievements, performance in the All-India Common Entrance Test or through the "Aryavart International University Entrance Test" / Merit, whichever is applicable.

The university reserves the right to conduct interviews or additional evaluations for shortlisted candidates, as deemed necessary.

## **2. IMPLEMENTATION OF SECTION 10(ii) - RESERVATION POLICY**

### **2.1 Reservation in Admission of Students:**

The University undertakes to follow the reservation policy as per the Aryavart International University Act and guidelines received from the Government of Tripura from time to time, for private universities as per provision of the Act.

The university is committed to transparency, fairness, and regular monitoring to ensure that such provisions reach deserving students without compromising academic excellence or merit. Special concessions are provided to candidates belonging to the EWS category.

### **2.2 Reservation in Posts and Employment:**

The University is unequivocally open to individuals from all backgrounds, including those from diverse classes, castes, creeds, faiths, regions, languages, genders, and nationalities, embracing diversity as a fundamental element of its academic and institutional ethos. Recruitment to all posts in the University shall be based primarily on merit, while ensuring broad accessibility and equal opportunity for all eligible candidates.

Reservation in appointments and recruitment to employee posts for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), and Other Backward Classes (OBC) among citizens shall be provided in accordance with the applicable policies, rules, and norms of the Government of India and the Government of Tripura, as applicable.

## **3. ORDINANCES MADE UNDER SECTION 31(i)**

The University has framed and notified the following Ordinances under Section 31(i) of the Aryavart International University, Tripura Act, 2023:

- (a) The University provides reservations for students belonging to weaker and backward sections of society in strict alignment with the prevailing policies of the State Government. Admission of students to any course is subject to their eligibility criteria. These provisions ensure equitable access while upholding academic standards.
- (b) The courses of study for all degrees are predefined and approved by the Academic Council of the University.
- (c) The medium of classroom instruction is bilingual, comprising English and Hindi, except for the linguistic subjects like Bengali and Kokborok.
- (d) The award of degrees, diplomas, certificates, and other academic distinctions is conferred upon successful evaluation and with the prior approval of the Academic Council of the University.
- (e) The fees to be charged for courses of study in the University, as well as for admission to examinations, degrees, diplomas, and certificates, are determined with the prior approval of the University's Finance Committee.
- (f) Awards of fellowships, scholarships, studentships, medals, and prizes are determined based on a student's performance in academics and extra-curricular activities. Students receive financial assistance through various scholarship programs, including the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) and Chancellor's Scholarship. Additionally, support is extended to students in securing educational loans from banks.

- (g) The University implements the conduct of examinations through duly constituted Boards of Examiners and Moderation Committees, appointed for a fixed tenure as prescribed in the University Ordinances. Their roles, responsibilities, and operational procedures are strictly followed to ensure transparency, confidentiality, academic integrity, and compliance with UGC and statutory regulations.
- (h) The University operates on a day shift basis, primarily catering to students from the local area. However, Paying Guest accommodations are provided at affordable rates for students coming from outside the locality.
- (i) Currently, the University does not have female students from outside the locality. However, provisions exist for special arrangements to accommodate female students in the future.
- (j) The appointment and emoluments of employees, other than those for whom provisions have been made in the statutes, are regulated in accordance with the guidelines of the University Grants Commission (UGC), the State Government, and the University Act.
- (k) The University has established a Board of Studies. It also maintains provisions for the establishment of Centres of Studies, Interdisciplinary Studies, Special Centres, and similar academic entities in the current period and the near future.
- (l) The University has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with IBM and DME, Govt. of Tripura, as an academic partner. It has also signed MoUs with various colleges in and outside the State of Tripura to facilitate academic activities such as conferences, publications, student exchanges, and faculty exchanges. Furthermore, the University has established an incubation centre to promote entrepreneurship.
- (m) Various administrative committees and cells have been constituted, including the Training & Placement Cell, Grievance Redressal Cell, Anti-Ragging Cell, and Caste-Based Discrimination Cell, to address student-related issues effectively.
- (n) The remuneration is paid to the examiners, invigilators and tabulators as per university norms.
- (o) While the statutes are being strictly adhered to, provisions exist therein for effecting necessary amendments to the terms and conditions of service of teachers and other academic staff as circumstances may warrant.
