

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Article 1: This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the "MoU") is entered into on this the 24th Day of May Two Thousand Twenty Four

AND

ARYAVART INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY, Dharmanagar, Tripura, **THE SECOND PARTY** represented herein by its **Registrar**

Mr. Deepak Bansal

WHEREAS the **FIRST** and **SECOND PARTIES** together have been referred to as **PARTIES** and jointly referred to as **INSTITUTIONS**.

Article 2: Background of the MoU

- WHEREAS, both the PARTIES aim at improving academic environment and mandate framing of collaboration policy thereto.
- WHEREAS, both the PARTIES have realized the need for a close linkage between the institutions in terms of research and academic activities.



NOW THE PARTIES ("C. M. COLLEGE" AND "ARYAVART INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY") HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE AND agree to work on collaborative and joint endeavours in the areas of mutual interest by entering into this MoU covering the activities as detailed in Article 4 of the MoU.

Article 3: General

"C. M. COLLEGE" and "ARYAVART INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY" have many areas of common interest in academics, education and research such as Commerce, Languages, Humanities, Social Science and Professional Courses including Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) and Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA). Considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the areas of common interests.

Article 4: Proposed Objectives and Expected Outcomes

In consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this MoU, both the institutions agree to the following collaborative activities (so far as feasible) in the academic areas of mutual interest, on the basis of equality and reciprocity.

- **Academic Exchange Programmes:** The MoU will facilitate student and faculty exchange programmes, allowing students and educators from both the institutions to gain exposure to diverse academic and cultural environments.
- **Joint Research Initiatives:** The PARTIES shall collaborate on research projects fostering interdisciplinary studies in areas of mutual interests.
- **Short-and Long-term Faculty Exchange:** The PARTIES shall collaborate on faculty exchange between the two institutions for teaching and research.
- **Sharing of Educational Resources:** The MoU will promote the sharing of educational resources, including course materials, research publications and academic databases.
- **Joint Conferences, Workshops and Short-Term Courses:** The MoU will help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between the FIRST PARTY and "the SECOND PARTY" as and when required.
- **Cultural Exchange:** The PARTIES shall promote cultural exchange activities to enhance mutual understanding and respect for each other.



- Other mutually agreed educational or research programmes.

Article 5: Operational Mechanism and Dispute Settlement

BOTH THE PARTIES agree that the operational mechanism for a mutually agreed assignment shall be based on the consent of **BOTH THE PARTIES**. Any dispute shall be settled in a manner as agreed by **BOTH THE PARTIES**.



This MoU shall come into effect from the date of its signing by the competent authorities / representatives of both the **PARTIES**.






